
Area Map

Kettō



Overview

A village in Akiyama-gō, right on the Shin-etsu Trail. It can be hard to get supplies here, but there are accommodations and hot springs, making it a great place to get rid of the tiredness of the Trail. An official Shin-etsu Trail tent site is here, unusual for being within a village. Public transportation is available from the Tsunan Station direction via scheduled bus and on-demand bus (reservation required).

A shared taxi requiring advanced reservations. Access is from Tsunan Station, first taking a fixed-route bus to Kodama, then transferring to the on-demand bus.
